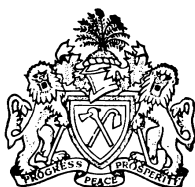

## **TRAVEL ADVISORY TO THE GAMBIA**

The Embassy wishes to inform individuals desirous to travel to the Republic of The Gambia that a Press Release issued on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2021 by the Ministry of Health updated the entry requirements to The Gambia with effect from 16<sup>th</sup> December 2021.

<b>Category I: Fully vaccinated travellers</b>	<b>Category II: Non vaccinated or partially vaccinated travellers</b>	<b>Category III: Travellers from Omicron variant hotspot countries<sup>1</sup></b>	<b>Category IV: Children (10 years and below)</b>

Avail oneself to testing centres for Rapid Diagnostic Test (RDT) if signs and symptoms noticed.	<b>Travellers from Delta variant hotspot countries<sup>2</sup></b> will undergo RDT at the airport upon arrival.	Quarantine upon arrival at own cost for PCR test to be conducted. Quarantine duration depends on outcome of test.	From Omicron variant hotspot countries, will undergo PCR Test upon arrival.
RDT for Covid-19 at the airport if signs and or symptoms noticed.			
<b><i>Travellers from Omicron variant hotspot countries will undergo Category III protocols.</i></b>
